Kasa as Arishta Suchak lakshan

The patients showing such symptoms invariable leads to death.Cha. Indriya. 6/9 Patient remains only with skin and has low grade fever before 12 noon and also has dry cough, dies soon.A. S. 6/10

Patient suffering mainly from fever and cough and is asthmatic excretes very less quantity of urine and obviously shows the signs of dehydration.Patient will not survive. Cha. Chi.. 6/15 Patients having productive cough sputum in abundant quantity, lok blue, yellow and always show presence of blood in sputum, dies invariably.

Su. su 38 If patient has diarrhoea, fever, hikka, asthigranthi, nidra, & severe dehydration dies very early.
